During the course of his life, Jack's philanthropy knew no bounds and he often quietly supported organizations and individuals with no fanfare or recognition. He was a visionary. This scholarship is for a student who is currently enrolled as either a high school junior or senior looking to study the performing arts outside of the Wood River Valley. Applicants should be able to demonstrate that they have exhausted all opportunities for performing arts study within the valley and have a strong work samples.
