### Job Summary

Sun Valley Museum of Art seeks interns for a new High School Internship program during the 2021/2022 school year. High School Internships are an opportunity for students to learn about and participate in the operations of a multidisciplinary arts institution with a focus on visual arts, education and humanities, and performing arts. Interns will gain job experience, benefit from mentorship, develop communication skills and build connections within the Wood River Valley community.

Students in grades 10-12 at any Blaine County high school are invited to apply for 3 internship positions offered:

- Feb 15-Apr 15.

Interns will be paid \$15/hour for their participation and should commit to 16-24 hours of time over the course of the internship, including weekly group meetings.

### Job Duties and Responsibilities May Include:

- Organizing exhibition tours for other students
- Helping create exhibition interpretive materials and activities for teens and families
- Organizing a teen workshop in the visual arts
- Organizing student book discussions or film screenings
- Assisting with programs such as lectures, exhibition preparation, and more
- Assisting with events such as concerts and performances
