IN A LANDSCAPE is an immersive outdoor music experience and as such, goes to locations that are wild and off the grid. In that spirit, SVMoA has worked with the Wood River Land Trust to provide a unique location for this event!

Simons-Bauer Preserve is a brand-new piece of protected property located immediately west of Lions Park parking lot and ballfield. It is a field and wetlands area that is not mowed or planted with lawn. Chairs aren't provided. There will be porta-potties in the parking lot area. We encourage you to treat this as a tiny hike and picnic adventure. Bring what you need and want, and will pack it all out, too!

**Parking is limited**—so please carpool if you can or ride a bike or walk. We will have a few designated handicap spots close to the entrance.

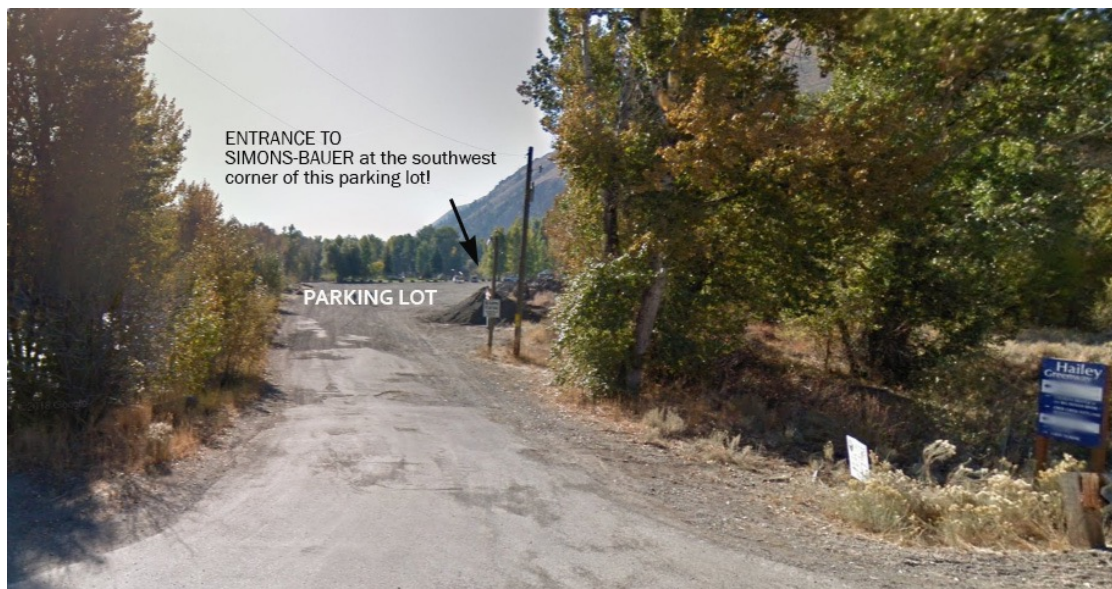
## WHERE IS THE CONCERT?

- Simons-Bauer Preserve. *It's new, so isn't located on maps, yet!*
- Search for Lions Park, Hailey (255 Croy Creek Road) for directions.
- Turn west onto Bullion Street from Main Street/Highway 75. Bullion turns into Croy Creek Road after crossing the bridge at the Big Wood River. The turn for the parking lot into Lions Park/Bow Bridge access is immediately after the bridge.

### **DO I NEED A PRINTED, PHYSICAL TICKET?**

- In the spirit of conservation, we'll have names on a will-call list to check you off on arrival.

### **WHAT SHOULD I WEAR?**

- We suggest closed-toe shoes and pants if it's not too hot. The grass is long and dry and there are bushes.

### **WHAT SHOULD I BRING?**

- Chairs.
- A blanket or small tarp to go under your chair—the dry grass is a bit prickly!
- A water bottle.
- A picnic if you'd like—keep it small since you'll need to walk to the preserve.
- A hat or umbrella for shade—there are no shady spots in this location.
- Please be sure to pack out everything you bring.

### **MAY I BRING MY DOG?**

- Please leave your dogs at home.

### **WHERE DO I PARK? AND HOW FAR IS THE WALK TO THE LOCATION?**

- Please use the parking lot at Lions Park or Hop Porter Park.
- If you can walk or ride a bike, please do.
- If you'd like to drop off your chairs, blankets, etc. close to the entrance and then go find parking, you may!
- You will need to check in at the entrance at the southwest corner of the parking lot next to the baseball field to receive your headphones.
- The walk to the preserve has a little slope down and winds through the trees. It's about 150 steps—about 1/10 of a mile.
- If you have accessibility issues, please do let us know in advance so that we can troubleshoot.

### **HOW LONG WILL THE CONCERT LAST?**

- 70-90 minutes

### **WHAT DOES THE VENUE LOOK LIKE?**

Here's what the Simons-Bauer Preserve looks like! Please note that the long, green grass in the distance is wetlands—do not set up chairs in that area. This photo is taken from Croy Creek Road—the piano will probably be located behind the low cluster of trees at the middle-left. Be sure to enter from the Lions Park parking lot as that is where we'll give you your headphones!
