DESCRIPTION

This scholarship is named for Kay Hardy and Gregory Kaslo, long-time supporters of arts and education in the state of Idaho. This award is given to high school seniors enrolled at Wood River High School, Silver Creek High School, or Carey School who are pursuing advanced study in the arts or humanities, including a specific program, trade school, college, an internship or apprenticeship. A total of 6 awards are given annually, a \$1000 award and an honorable mention award of \$665 at each of the three high schools.
