DESCRIPTION

This scholarship is designed for Blaine County high school students currently enrolled in grades 9–12 looking to further their artistic pursuits in the visual arts, performing arts and/or humanities. Scholarships can be used for summer study programs or programs during the school year with local schools or individual instructors. Students can receive up to \$2500. Multiple awards are given. **WHEN CHOOSING A PROGRAM:** The committee is more likely to award a student who has taken advantage of their local learning opportunities. **PROGRAM EXAMPLES:** Footlight Dance/SV Ballet, The Spot!, St. Thomas Playhouse, Boulder Mountain Clayworks, Sun Valley Summer Symphony, CSI, SVMoA visual arts classes, Rocky Mountain School of Photography, pre-college arts programs with University of Idaho, Boise State University, Pratt Institute (NY), Cornish College, Rhode Island School of Design, Idylwild Summer Arts Camp.

- Applicant is currently enrolled in 9th–12th grade in the Wood River Valley
- Program or lessons in arts or humanities related field of study (visual, literary, or performing, etc.)

- **Visual Arts:** Please provide 5 to 12 images. Must include the title of the work, size of the work, and medium. We recommend you make a PowerPoint/Google Slides presentation and save it as a PDF file.
- **Performing Arts:** Please avoid group performances as the committee does not know who to look for. We recommend providing a YouTube Link.
- **Humanities:** Please provide a writing sample.
