WENDY & ALAN PESKY EDUCATOR SCHOLARSHIP

Blaine County educators pursuing professional development linking to the arts and humanities. Recipients may receive up to \$1,200.

GAY V. WEAKE SCHOLARSHIP

Seniors in high school or full-time college students pursuing arts and humanities majors. Renewal award where recipients receive \$2,000 each year of undergraduate study.

HARDY KASLO ARTS & HUMANITIES SCHOLARSHIP

Public high school seniors pursuing advanced study in the arts or humanities, including a specific program, trade school, college, an internship or apprenticeship. Recipients receive up to \$1,000.

JACK THORNTON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS

Public, private and home-schooled students in Blaine County currently enrolled in 11th or 12th grade pursuing study outside of their regular school hours in the performing arts. Recipient will receive \$3,000.

HIGH SCHOOL ARTS & HUMANITIES SCHOLARSHIP

Public, private and home-schooled students in Blaine County currently enrolled in grades 9th–12th pursuing study outside of their regular school hours in the arts and humanities. Recipients can receive up to \$2,500.

THAT TIME I KNEW I BELONGED: WRITING COMPETITION

High school juniors and seniors who attend Blaine County public schools. Winners will receive up to \$1,000 to purchase books for college or technical school, or to support a love of reading.

Scholarship funds must be used between April 2024–February 2025. Children of full-time SVMoA employees and board members are not eligible for scholarships.
