DESCRIPTION

This scholarship is named for Kay Hardy and Gregory Kaslo, longtime supporters of arts and education in the state of Idaho. This award is given to high school seniors enrolled at Wood River High School, Silver Creek High School, or Carey School who are pursuing study in the arts or humanities, including a specific program, trade school, college, an internship or apprenticeship. Areas of study may include visual art, music, dance, performance, graphic design, architecture, woodworking, creative writing, media, etc. A total of 6 awards are given annually, a \$1000 award and an honorable mention award of \$665 at each of the three high schools.

- Intended field of study = in an area of primary interest as described above (arts or humanities)

C. SUPPLEMENTS

Choose one. Write a response of 300-350 words.

- When you are inspired by an artwork, performance, written word, object, or person, what does that inspiration mean to you?
- Art makes the world a better place. Agree or disagree. Explain your answer.

D. OPTIONAL WORK SAMPLES

• Submit something that illustrates and/or supports your answer to the supplemental prompt.

E. TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

No relatives. Must be submitted online by your recommenders. Share the recommendation link found on our website with your recommenders.
